**Monday’s Sun-day!**

According to NASA, this Monday, August 21, 2017, most of North America will be treated to an eclipse of the sun. Anyone within the path of totality can see one of nature’s most awe-inspiring sights - a **total solar eclipse!** This path, where the moon will completely cover the sun, will stretch from Oregon to South Carolina. Getting a chance to see a total solar eclipse is rare. The moon’s shadow on earth isn’t very big, and it has to happen during daylight time to be seen. On average, the same spot on earth only gets to see a total solar eclipse every 375 years!

As amazing as this will be, there will come a day when the sun is not just eclipsed, but extinguished! In speaking of the second coming of “the son of Man,” Jesus said, “the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from heaven” (Mt.24: 27-29). (The sun itself is just a star you know.)

Our planet could not exist without the sun and its light and energy. So how will we survive in Heaven without it? Jesus let us know that the heavenly city “will have no need of sun or moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and its lamp is the Lamb (Re. 21:23). Let us enjoy and be amazed by this Monday’s solar eclipse, and be reminded of, and be ready for the day the sun is totally extinguished!
